Project Scope

- Construction of a new 36-inch transmission water main to improve reliability and operational flexibility in delivering water from KUB's treatment plant to the west side of the distribution system
- Replaces aging distribution mains with new 8-, 12-, and 16-inch pipe as part of the Century II program

Project Overview

- 8,500 feet of 36-inch water main
- 1,400 feet of 8-, 12-, and 16-inch water main
- Project cost: \$6.4 million

Project Details

- Safety of the public and workers during this project is KUB's highest priority
- Construction methods include boring and open-cut trenching
- Existing water main and services will remain active until construction and tie-ins to the new water mains are completed
- Property and pavement will be restored after construction
- Milling and paving of affected lanes

Traffic Impacts

- Construction in block-to-block sections
- Entire project area will not be impacted at one time; however, two or more locations may be constructed simultaneously
- Lane, sidewalk, and limited road closures in immediate work zones with approved traffic control measures
- Access to businesses and parking areas maintained

Project Schedule

- Construction prep work and mobilization November 2017
- Construction completion by May 2019
- Weekday work generally during daylight hours
- Some overnight work to minimize customer and traffic impacts


