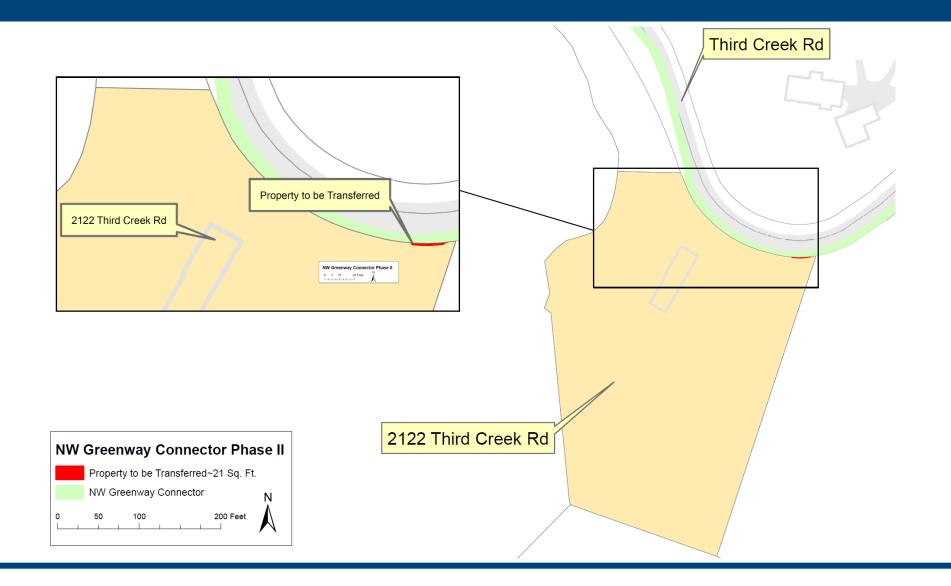
#### Overview

- Entire parcel is approximately 2.27 acres
- Property contains KUB's Third Creek Booster Pump Station
- City of Knoxville is expanding the Third Creek Greenway
- Requests 21 square feet be transferred to improve line of site

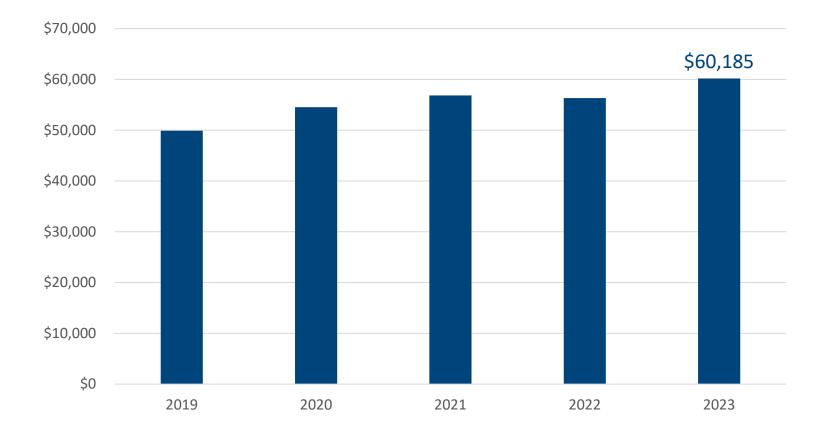

# What is PrePay Billing?

- PrePay Billing allows customers to pay for utility services in advance
- Amount of service consumed tracked and funds subtracted daily
- Customers add funds as they are depleted

#### **Benefits of PrePay**

Reduced deposit requirements

Avoid late payments and late fees

Better visibility of utility consumption

Encourages energy conservation

Potential cost savings

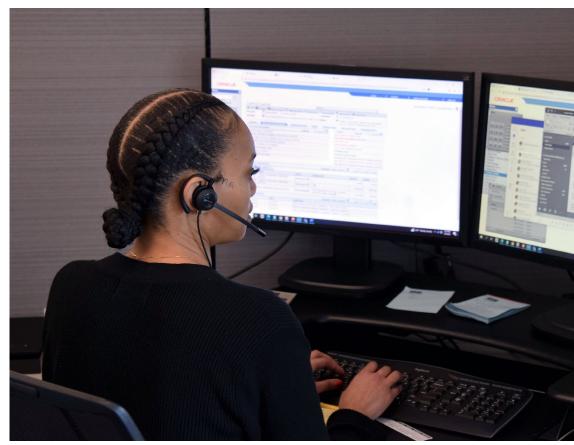
Reduced risk of debt accumulation

# What is Different about PrePay Billing?

- Payment due before use
- Lower deposit to start service
- Daily billing and online billing report
- No connection and reconnection fees
- Email and/or text notifications for low balance and pending disconnection
- Disconnection when balance reaches \$0 regardless of day
- Immediate reconnection after payment

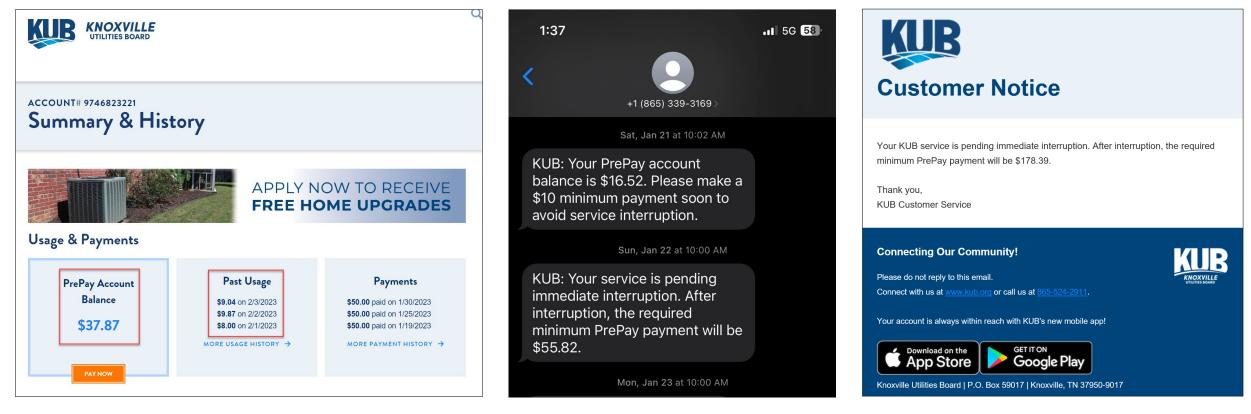
### How to Enroll in PrePay Billing

- Residential customers with KUB electric service
- Establish or use existing KUB.org/mobile app account
- Pay minimal deposit and initial utility service payment
- Receive overview of program benefits and conditions from customer service representative

- Evaluate program adoption and effectiveness



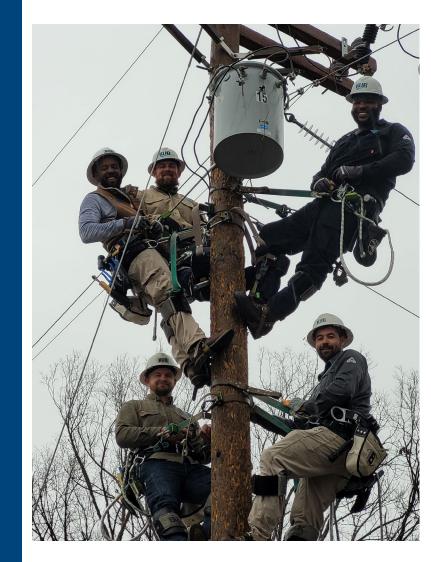
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#### **KUB** Apprenticeship Programs



#### Lineworker Apprentice Program Background

- Apprentice program initiated in 1980s
  - Memorandum with IBEW since 1940s
- Five steps to complete to become Journeyman
- Probation extends through apprenticeship
- KUB-sponsored lineworker school
- Currently employing 17 apprentices



#### Latest Successes

- 2022:
  - Transitioned to TCAT Oneida for lineworker school
    - Critical partnership now a recruiting pipeline
  - Eleven new apprentices hired
    - KUB's first female lineworker Amber Ray

• 2023:

- Two additional hired Jan. 9, 2023
  - Second female lineworker – Haley Comer

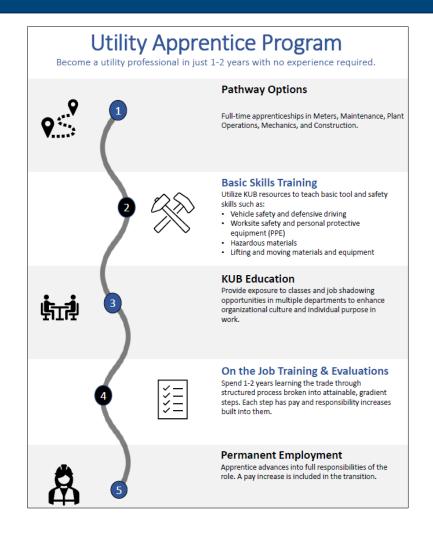
### Utility Apprentice Program Background

#### • Program objectives:

- Create pipeline for future skilled craft workers
- Increase opportunities for community partnerships
- Support diversity, equity, and inclusion efforts
- Provide career opportunities beyond TeenWork
- Hired first "pilot" Utility Apprentice in April 2021
- Hired five additional Utility Apprentices in October 2022

# Utility Apprenticeship Program Details

- Creative recruiting methods
  - Extensive personal outreach
- Train-the-trainer session with mentors
- Expanded onboarding during first week
  - Safety, ergonomics, defensive driving, facility tours



#### **Current Class**

- Utility Apprentices in Meters (2), Plants, System Maintenance, Transportation
- Regular check-ins with apprentices and mentors
  - Three-month evaluations positive
- Upcoming events:
  - Fiber education session
  - Budgeting course
  - Feedback session with mentors



# Kalen's Journey

- Started as a TeenWorker in 2019
- Hired as a student when enrolled at Pellissippi in December 2020
- Transitioned to Utility Apprentice in System Maintenance Services in April 2021
- Transferred to Underground Construction in January 2022
  - CDL acquired Nov. 10, 2022
- Promoted to Construction Technician I on Feb. 6, 2023
