## **UPDATE:**

*NOTE: Crews will not work on Monday, July 5, in observance of Independence Day.*

KUB Overhead Construction crews are upgrading portions of the overhead electric system in the Halls and Powell communities. Crews are currently working in the vicinity of W. Chermont Circle, Cynruss Drive, and N. Fountaincrest Drive. The overall project extends along a corridor from the Andersonville Pike substation to the Dry Gap Pike substation in off-road easements between Emory Road and Cunningham Road. The attached map shows the entire length of the construction zone. Tree pruning and vegetation clearance may be required within the utility easement rights-of-way to facilitate safe access and proper clearances. Customers in the vicinity of the immediate work zone may notice temporary elevated noise levels associated with the operation of heavy trucks and equipment. Crews will complete this work during daylight hours. Some weekend work may also be required to facilitate timely completion of this project.
