Commissioners:

As you know, the April 20 meeting includes a workshop on the proposed financial budget for fiscal year 2024, however, prior to the workshop, there is one official action item on the Board agenda for your consideration. An overview of the resolution is provided below.

Resolution 1475

KUB previously submitted grant applications under the Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan to help fund the deployment of broadband services to unserved locations within KUB's electric service territory.

As you will recall, KUB was awarded \$15.3 million in grants for the deployment of broadband services in Union, Grainger, Sevier, and Jefferson Counties.

The contracts from the state awarding the \$15.3 million in grants included a provision for KUB's governing body to adopt a resolution authorizing KUB to file applications for the grants. The need for an authorizing resolution had not been previously communicated by the state.

Upon discussions with the state and our legal counsel, Resolution 1475 has been prepared authorizing KUB to apply for Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan grants, with such authorization to be retroactive to a date preceding KUB's filing of the grant applications.

A draft of Resolution 1475 is enclosed for your information. I recommend its adoption on first and final reading.

RESOLUTION NO. 1475

A Resolution Authorizing Knoxville Utilities Board ("KUB") to Apply for Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan Grants

Whereas, by Resolution No. 1439, this Board authorized KUB to provide broadband services to the fullest extent permitted by applicable Tennessee law; and

Whereas, among the KUB goals for offering broadband service is to make broadband service available to all customers in KUB's electric utility service area, including rural areas served by KUB in Knox, Union, Grainger, Sevier, and Jefferson counties; and

Whereas, to aid KUB's goal of deployment of broadband services to unserved locations within KUB's electric service territory, KUB desires to seek grant funding under the Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan; and

Whereas, the Board supports the effort to deploy service to unserved locations within KUB's electric service territory, including the grant of authority for KUB to apply for grants from Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Hereby Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the Knoxville Utilities Board:

- 1. The Board hereby authorizes the filing of applications for Tennessee Emergency Broadband Fund-American Rescue Plan ("Program") grants for Knox, Union, Grainger, Sevier and Jefferson counties, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, and directs the President and CEO, or his designee, to act in connection with the applications and to provide such additional information as may be required.
- 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and shall be deemed by this Board to apply retroactively to July 1, 2021, a date preceding KUB's filing of applications for Program grants.
