UPDATE:

Construction/Traffic: McCroskey Avenue – KUB contractor crews will continue work on the section of McCroskey Avenue between N. Broadway and Howard Street through next week. This section of McCroskey Avenue will be closed to through traffic daily from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Access to driveways will be maintained. Alternate routes include Chicago Avenue. This section of McCroskey Avenue will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of list work hours. Appropriate signage will be placed on site to assist with traffic control. Crews will begin cleanup and restoration on McCroskey Avenue following construction.

Chicago Avenue – Once construction has been completed on McCroskey Avenue, crews are scheduled to begin work on Chicago Avenue. Chicago Avenue will be closed to through traffic daily from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. between N. Broadway and Nadine Street as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Access to driveways will be maintained. Alternate routes include Coker Avenue. This section of Chicago Avenue will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of list work hours. Appropriate signage will be placed on site to assist with traffic control.

Restoration: Wastewater pipeline and manhole work has been completed at previous construction zones on Washington Pike, Coker Avenue, and Lawson Avenue and work has shifted to cleanup and restoration. Intermittent temporary lane and sidewalk closures may be needed as paving and restoration work continues in these areas.
