



# Kuwahee Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project

### Scope of Work

- Kuwahee Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrades from January 2019 through February 2021

### Project Overview

- **Plant Upgrades:** Construction of a Biologically Enhanced High-Rate Clarification System (BEHRC) at existing site to provide full treatment capacity during peak wet-weather flows

### Traffic Impacts

- **Neyland Drive Lane Shifts (January 2019 through February 2021)**
  - Neyland Drive: eastbound curbside lane closed and traffic flow shifted to second lane and center turn lane east of Joan Cronan Way (see map on reverse)
- No left turns from Neyland Drive eastbound lanes into Kuwahee Plant main entrance
- Eastbound traffic must access KUB plant via Joan Cronan Way
- Traffic channeling devices will remain in place to assist with maintaining traffic flow for the duration of this project
- Access to all University of Tennessee facilities will remain open on this section of Neyland Drive

### Neyland Greenway Impacts

- **Kuwahee Plant Upgrade Project**
  - Neyland Greenway closed intermittently in areas adjacent to Kuwahee Plant along the Tennessee River
  - KUB will coordinate all work impacting this section of the Neyland Greenway with City of Knoxville Parks and Recreation
  - All Neyland Greenway closures will be communicated in advance
