

MAJOR PROJECT UPDATE

This project is being completed as part of KUB's Century II infrastructure improvement and replacement programs.



PROJECT TITLE: Old North Knox Area/Mini-Basin 17A1b Wastewater Rehabilitation Project

UPDATE:

KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, January 09, through Friday, January 13, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow any onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Manhole Replacement – Contractor crews will be placing new a manhole in easement between Camp Avenue and Wells Avenue.

Lateral Reconnection – Contractor crews will begin lateral reconnection for rehabilitated wastewater pipes located in easement between Camp Avenue and Wells Avenue.

Open Cut – Contractor crews will begin open cut replacement of the wastewater pipe in easement between Camp Avenue and Wells Avenue.

CCTV Inspections – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.

Additional traffic impacts:

(North Knox) N Broadway Lane Closures (Daily, January 9-27, 2023) – KUB contractor crews will implement temporary lane closures along the section of N Broadway between McCroskey Avenue and Kenyon Street daily from 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. starting on Monday, January 9, and lasting through, Friday, January 27, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area.

The inside southbound and center turn lanes will be closed on this section of N Broadway. The southbound curbside lane of N Broadway, the southbound Hall of Fame Drive access ramp, and both northbound lanes of N Broadway will remain open. Channeling devices will be present to assist with maintaining local traffic flow. Appropriate signage will be placed around the construction zone to assist with traffic control. All lanes will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of work hours.

Some closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas.
