UPDATE:

Minibasin 17A1b project traffic impacts for week of November 7 – 11:

KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, November 7, through Friday, November 11, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent Lane/Road Closures
 - o Armstrong Avenue between Kenyon Street and Bluff Avenue
 - o Kenyon Street between Armstrong Avenue and Fremont Place
 - o Thompson Place Alleyway

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Manhole Replacement – Contractor crews will be replacing manholes on Armstrong Avenue and Thompson Place Alleyway.

Lateral Reconnection – Contractor crews will begin lateral reconnection for rehabilitated wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue and Thompson Place Alleyway.

Point Repair – Contractor crews will begin a point repair of the wastewater pipe on Kenyon Street.

Pipe Burst – Contractor crews will begin pipe bursting rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue and Thompson Place Alleyway.

CCTV Inspections – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.



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
