## UPDATE:

**Traffic:** KUB contractor crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, July 25, through Friday, July 29, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent Road Closures
  - o Harvey Street between Armstrong Avenue and Folsom Avenue
  - o Armstrong Avenue between Kern Place and Kenyon Street
  - o Fremont Place between Kenyon Street and Bluff Avenue

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**Manhole Replacement** – Contractor crews will be replacing manholes on Armstrong Avenue between Kern Place and Kenyon Street.

**CIPP** – Contractor crews will begin cured-in-place rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on Harvey Street and Fremont Place.

**CCTV Inspections** – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.
