UPDATE:

Traffic: KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, August 22, through Friday, August 26, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent Lane/Road Closures
 - o Armstrong Avenue between Wells Avenue and Kenyon Street
 - o N. Broadway between Wells Avenue and Kenyon Street (lane closures only)
 - o Luttrell Street between Wells Avenue and E. Glenwood Avenue

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Manhole Replacement - Contractor crews will be replacing manholes on N. Broadway between Wells Avenue and Kenyon Street.

CIPP - Contractor crews will begin cured-in-place rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue, N. Broadway, and Luttrell Street.

Pipe Bursting - Contractor crews will begin pipe bursting rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on N. Broadway.

CCTV Inspections - Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.
