## UPDATE:

**Traffic** – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, August 29, through Friday, September 2, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent Lane/Road Closures
  - o Armstrong Avenue between Wells Avenue and Kenyon Street
  - o E. Glenwood Avenue between N. Broadway and Luttrell Street
  - o Luttrell Street between Wells Avenue and E. Glenwood Avenue

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

**Manhole Replacement** – Contractor crews will be replacing manholes on Armstrong Avenue between Wells Avenue and Kenyon Street.

**CIPP** – Contractor crews will begin cured-in-place rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue and Luttrell Street.

**Pipe Bursting** – Contractor crews will begin pipe bursting rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on E. Glenwood Drive and Armstrong Avenue.

**CCTV Inspections** – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.
