UPDATE:

KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, September 12, through Friday, September 16, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent Lane/Road Closures
 - o Armstrong Avenue between Wells Avenue and Thompson Place
 - o Thompson Place perpendicular to Armstrong Avenue
 - o Luttrell Street between Wells Avenue and E. Glenwood Avenue

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Manhole Replacement – Contractor crews will be replacing manholes on Armstrong Avenue between Wells Avenue and Thompson Place

Pipe Bursting – Contractor crews will begin pipe bursting rehabilitation of the wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue and Thompson Place.

Lateral Reconnection – Contractor crews will begin lateral reconnection for rehabilitated wastewater pipes located on Armstrong Avenue and Luttrell Avenue.

CCTV Inspections – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire project area.
