Wanted: Utility Contractors for Prequalification

To ensure KUB has an adequate pool of qualified utility construction contractors, KUB's Procurement Department has a Contractor Prequalification Program that includes all construction contractors (electric, fiber, gas, water, wastewater, vegetation management, and paving). Below is an outline of KUB's Contractor Prequalification Program Process.

- Contractor can download Section A-C forms from this link: www.kub.org/about/procurement/ contractor-prequalification
- Completed Section A-C forms should be emailed to kubprequal@kub.org for review
- Upon KUB approval of Section A–C, the applicant will be sent Section D, which requires the contractor to submit three references and detail any previous construction projects with KUB within the last three years
- If Sections A-D are approved by KUB, applicants are to submit remaining requirements to Avetta, which KUB uses to prequalify contractors
- A scorecard rating of 60 or greater and a classification of "Compliant" or "Conditional" in Avetta is required to be prequalified
