## **Get to Know KUB Contract Specialist Zach Breeding**



**How long have you been at KUB and where area did you start?** I started as a student in HR in 1998 and was hired full time in Procurement in March of 1999. I've been full time for 23 years.

What are some of the challenges for new and small businesses and could they overcome those? The biggest challenge I'd say, particularly for construction contractors, is gaining similar or relevant work experience, particularly for those wanting to perform work in one of the pre-qualified categories. (Electric, Water, Wastewater, Gas, Fiber, Vegetation Management and Paving). During my time, KUB has preferred for companies to have other relevant experience prior to trying to work for us. Also, new or small businesses may not be familiar with working for a public entity and all the bidding requirements that go with that (ex. Having a state contractor's license, bonding requirements, navigating the Periscopeholdings.com/s2g bidding portal, etc.)

What advice would you give vendors wanting to do business with KUB? Ask questions and don't hesitate to start by being a subcontractor first before trying to be a prime contractor. Attending pre-bids is a good way to connect with prime contractors and figure out how to bid on construction projects. Also, if you're selling goods, provide one of the Procurement buyers details of your products and they can send that information to internal customers who may be interested in considering your product.

The Procurement Department is responsible for materials, supplies, services, construction, and maintenance purchases separated into these categories:

#### **Small Purchases:**

Purchases between \$0-\$4,999: No competition required

#### **Formal Competitive Process:**

- Purchases between \$5,000-\$24,999: Three written quotes
- Purchases \$25,000+: Requires publicly advertised bids

KUB was approved in 2021 to provide fiber internet services to customers within its electric service territory, which includes more than 210,000 households in Knox and parts of seven surrounding counties. KUB's municipal broadband will launch in fall 2022 and will be available to approximately 30,000 customers in its first phase. KUB Fiber will provide 100% symmetrical fiber, which means faster upload and download speeds, at an affordable price.
