Small Business Enterprise Program

The KUB Small Business Enterprise program has been updated! Small business bids are now for projects up to \$150,000 with a 5% preference for any business who is headquartered within KUB's service territory. These changes will allow additional competition for small and local businesses. Last year, KUB spent \$740,998 in small business bids, with \$149,244 of that going directly to Knoxville businesses.

1. Stay connected.

- Register at www.BidNetDirect.com and follow KUB Procurement on X to receive bid notifications.
- Visit www.kub.org/about/procurement and click "View Open Bids And Requests For Proposals."

2. Stay organized.

 Make sure to read the entire bid package and make a checklist of all required bid documents. Make the closing date the main point of your checklist.

3. Seek feedback.

• If you don't win a bid, follow up with the buyer and ask for your results to improve your chances of success in the future.

4. Learn more about KUB.

 Gain knowledge and insight by attending pre-bid meetings to network with contractors. Be sure to talk to KUB representatives and ask plenty of questions.

5. Don't give up!

• Consistency can go a long way.
