UPDATE:

Cherokee Boulevard Lane Closure [January 24-25] – KUB's wastewater project contractor will perform work on the City of Knoxville's stormwater system next week in the vicinity of 481 Cherokee Boulevard. To facilitate this work, City of Knoxville Engineering will provide traffic control and close southbound lane of Cherokee Boulevard between Kingston Pike and Cheowa Circle daily from 7a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, January 24, and Tuesday, January 25. The northbound lane of Cherokee Boulevard and the Sequoyah Greenway will remain open. Driveway access will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Through traffic will need to follow detour signage for alternate routes. See attached map.

Wastewater Collection System Rehabilitation Project - Phase 3:

KUB contract crews will perform work on the wastewater collection system in the following off-roads areas:

- o Cured-In-Place Liner (CIPP) Installation
 - o Easement between Glenfield Drive and Dellwood Drive
 - o Easement between Kenilworth Drive and Oakhurst Drive
- o Manhole Rehabilitation
 - o Easement at 634 Scenic Drive
- o Point Repair
 - o Easement at 611 Cheowa Circle

Sequoyah Hills Shortline Water Main Replacement Projects Updates:

Bluff Drive Water Main Replacement – KUB Underground Construction crews continue installation of the new water main along Bluff Drive as weather conditions allow. This work is scheduled for completion by February 2022.

Restoration – Crews will work to restore roadways, sidewalks, curbs, and yards in recently excavated areas across the Phase 3 zone. Work in roadways will require short term lane/road closures.



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
