PROJECT TITLE: Sequoyah Hills Utility Projects

UPDATE ISSUE DATE: March 25, 2022

UPDATE: Sequoyah Park Parking & Boat Ramp Area Closure [March 28 & 30] – KUB contractor crews will close access to the Sequoyah Park parking and boat ramp area from 6 a.m., Monday, March 28, through 6 a.m., Wednesday, March 30, as paving and restoration work is completed. This area was used by KUB's contractor over the past several years as a staging area for construction equipment and materials for a three-phase wastewater collection system improvement project.



Phase 3 Wastewater Project – KUB contract crews will perform work on project punch-list items and restoration throughout Phase 3 wastewater project area over the next several weeks.

Bluff Drive Water Main Replacement – KUB Underground Construction have completed installation of the new water main along Bluff Drive. Clean-up and roadway restoration work will continue as weather allows over the next several weeks.

Utility Pole Inspections – KUB contractor Davey Resource Group will be working in the Sequoyah Hills area over the next several weeks to inspect utility poles to see if they require maintenance or replacement. In some cases, this will involve boring holes to inspect the inner core of the pole and/or digging a shallow trench at the base to inspect the condition of the pole below ground. Crews will clean up the area after inspection. This work will not require electric service interruptions.



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
