UPDATE:

KUB contractor crews will temporarily close the section of Cherokee Boulevard daily between Kenesaw Avenue and Woodland Drive, Monday, April 19, through Friday, April 23, as work is performed on wastewater collection system in the area. Local traffic access will be maintained. The roadway will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of work hours.

Additional Phase 3 area traffic impacts for week of April 19-23:

- Intermittent road closures (access for local residents will be maintained)
 - Boxwood Square and Boxwood Square Easement.
- Wastewater rehabilitation in off-road easements
 - Easement between Cherokee Boulevard and Cheowa Circle
 - Easement between Cherokee Boulevard and the Tennessee River
 - Easement Between Woodland Court and Cherokee Boulevard
- Intermittent lane closures as needed during work hours:
 - Lake View Drive

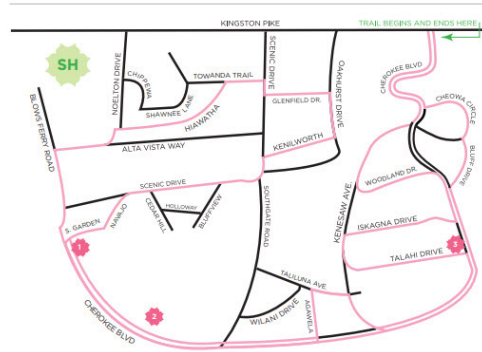

CCTV Inspections – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire Phase 3 area for the duration of the project. Due to the location of some manholes in the roadway, this work will require temporary lane closures with flaggers present to maintain traffic flow. Crews will also need to access manholes and pipes located in off-road easements.

Restoration – Crews will work in recently excavated areas across the Phase 3 zone starting next week. Work in roadways will require short term lane/road closures.
