
MAJOR PROJECT UPDATE

UPDATE:

KUB contractor crews will temporarily close the section of Cherokee Boulevard daily between Iskagna Drive and Talahi Drive Monday, May 3, through Friday, May 7, as work is performed on wastewater collection system in the area. Local traffic access will be maintained. The roadway will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of work hours.

Additional Phase 3 area traffic impacts for week of May 3-7:

- Intermittent road closures (access for local residents will be maintained)
 - o Boxwood Square and Boxwood Square Easement.
 - o Cheowa Circle Between Bluff Drive and Lake View Drive
- Wastewater rehabilitation in off-road easements
 - o Easement between Cherokee Boulevard and the Tennessee River
 - o Easement Between Woodland Court and Cherokee Boulevard
 - o Easement Between Kenesaw Avenue and Hillvale Circle
 - o Easement Between Dellwood Drive and Glenfield Drive
 - o Easement Between Scenic Drive and Dellwood Drive
- Intermittent lane closures as needed during work hours:
 - o Keowee Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Iskagna Drive








MAJOR PROJECT UPDATE

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CCTV Inspections – Contractor crews will be performing closed-circuit TV (CCTV) inspections of wastewater pipes and manholes at various locations across the entire Phase 3 area for the duration of the project. Due to the location of some manholes in the roadway, this work will require temporary lane closures with flaggers present to maintain traffic flow. Crews will also need to access manholes and pipes located in off-road easements.

Restoration – Crews will work in recently excavated areas across the Phase 3 zone starting next week. Work in roadways will require short term lane/road closures.

NOTE: Due to vacation schedules, the next major project update will be posted the week of May 10. Traffic impact notices will continue to be posted on KUB's social media platforms.

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
