
MAJOR PROJECT UPDATE

PROJECT TITLE: Sequoyah Hills Wastewater Collection System Rehabilitation Project - Phase 2

UPDATE:

Sequoyah Hills Phase 2 Wastewater Rehabilitation – Crews will work throughout the Phase 2 project area next week completing punch-list items, and performing paving repairs, clean-up and restoration. This work may require short duration lane closures daily between 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. as needed in the immediate zones where work is occurring.

Sequoyah Park – Cleanup and restoration of disturbed areas will continue through May 2020. See the attached map showing current work corridors within the park. The park, all entrances and parking areas, and boat ramp remain open during this work. Morgan Construction continues to maintain a fenced area in the middle parking lot for equipment and materials storage. KUB has coordinated work in the park with City of Knoxville Parks and Recreation and the Kingston Pike Sequoyah Hills Association.

Natural Gas System Work – KUB Underground Construction crews have completed most of the natural gas system work. Isolated work remains in off-road easements with no traffic impacts.

Sequoyah Hills Phase 3 Wastewater Rehabilitation Status Update – Wastewater collection system rehabilitation work planned for the northeast section of Sequoyah Hills (see attached map) has been temporarily postponed until further notice. The contractor materials storage area near the boat ramp in Sequoyah Park will also be removed upon completion of Phase 2. The same area will be used for contractor material storage when Phase 3 begins. KUB will coordinate communication efforts with the Kingston Pike Sequoyah Hills Neighborhood Association and the City of Knoxville Parks and Recreation Department to notify residents well ahead of the start of construction activity on this portion of this multi-phase project.
