

# MAJOR PROJECT UPDATE

## UPDATE:

KUB contractor Southern Constructors, Inc. (SCI), have substantially completed work on the underground electric vaults at 408 Union Avenue. Installation of the steel grate coverings and clean-up/restoration work remains. The new steel grate coverings are scheduled for delivery/installation by mid-to-late January 2021.

Demolition work has started on the vault located at 508 Union Avenue. Structural steel assembly work is also underway. A concrete pour is scheduled for Tuesday, December 22, at this location. Crews will clean-up and secure the area on Wednesday, December 23, before breaking for the Christmas holiday. Work will resume on Monday, December 28.

This project involves structural updates, including demolition and replacement of deteriorated concrete and addition of new steel beams in the vaults. Sidewalks in affected areas will be restored to current design (pavers or concrete) to City of Knoxville specifications following completion of work.

Electric service outages will not be required in association with this work. Sidewalks along south side of Union Avenue will be closed daily to pedestrian through traffic during daytime work hours – 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. Vehicle traffic flow and building/business access maintained on Union Avenue. Work hours 9 a.m.–3 p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. Due to holiday schedules, the next update for this project will be posted the week of January 4, 2021.
