UPDATE:

KUB contractor Southern Constructors, Inc. (SCI), has continued demolition of the damaged vault roofs and started installation of new steel supports at 408 Union Avenue. Concrete restoration work is scheduled for the week of December 7, as weather permits. Sidewalk paver restoration will follow.

This project involves structural updates, including demolition and replacement of deteriorated concrete and addition of new steel beams in the vaults. Sidewalks in affected areas will be restored to current design (pavers or concrete) to City of Knoxville specifications following completion of work.

Electric service outages will not be required in association with this work. Sidewalks along south side of Union Avenue will be closed daily to pedestrian through traffic during daytime work hours – 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. Vehicle traffic flow and building/business access maintained on Union Avenue.

Work hours 9 a.m.–3 p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. Crews will move to 508 Union Avenue for approximately 2-3 weeks immediately following completion of work at 408 Union Avenue.
