



Weatherization Programs

Knoxville Utilities Board has a long legacy of supporting low-income weatherization programs through its Round It Up program and partnerships like TVA's Home Uplift and the Knoxville Extreme Energy Makeover. These programs help break the cycle of high utility bills due to inefficient homes and ongoing needs for bill payment assistance.

Weatherization upgrades improve the energy efficiency of customer homes by replacing or upgrading inefficient home systems, such as the heat and air conditioner. Weatherization reduces energy consumption and utility bills while improving customer comfort and health by improving indoor air quality and reducing the stress low-income families face over their utility bill.



Improvements may include:

- Air sealing
- Duct sealing/replacement
- Attic insulation
- Water heater & pipe insulation
- Wall insulation
- HVAC clean & tune
- HVAC replacement
- Windows & door replacement
- Heat pump water heater
- Refrigerator
- LED bulbs
- Low-flow showerheads

How do I apply for weatherization?

Note: All applicants will be required to provide proof of income and proof of relevant utility usage.
