(South Knoxville) Chapman Highway Lane Closure [December 6-7] – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, southbound lane of Chapman Highway between E. Martin Mill Pike and E. Young High Pike, overnight from 10 p.m., Tuesday, December 6, to 6 a.m., Wednesday, December 7, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One southbound lane, the center turn lane, and both northbound lanes will remain open during this time. Flaggers and signs will be on-site to assist with traffic control.

(South Knoxville) Chapman Highway Lane Closure [December 7-8] – KUB crews will close a short section of the curbside, southbound lane of Chapman Highway between W. Blount Avenue and E. Martin Mill Pike, overnight from 10 p.m., Wednesday, December 7, to 6 a.m., Thursday, December 8, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. One southbound lane, the center turn lane, and both northbound lanes will remain open during this time. Flaggers and signs will be on-site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
