KUB Joins East Tennessee Clean Fuels Coalition's Tennessee Workplace Charging Partnership

Knoxville Utilities Board (KUB) is pleased to announce that it has joined the East Tennessee Clean Fuels Coalition's Tennessee Workplace Charging Partnership (TWCP). This partnership aims to advance the adoption of plug-in electric vehicles (PEVs) throughout the state.

In addition to providing reliable utility services, KUB acts as a good steward of resources in the communities we serve, and has a long history of making environmental responsibility a priority. KUB has been utilizing alternative fuels for its fleet since the 1970s and continues to expand its alternative fuel vehicle fleet. KUB is also a long-standing partner with East Tennessee Clean Fuels Coalition.

KUB currently has four Level 2 electric vehicle charging stations located in the Promenade Parking Garage on State Street in downtown Knoxville. These charging stations are available for use by both the public and KUB employees. There is no cost for using these stations, and KUB encourages those in the community with PEVs to use these charging stations when they visit downtown.
