(Downtown Knoxville) Market Street Road Closure [February 15] – KUB crews will close a short section of Market Street, between W. Church Avenue and Clinch Avenue, from 8 – 11 p.m., on Wednesday, February 15, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include W. Church Avenue, Walnut Street, and Clinch Avenue. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. The rain date for this work is Thursday, February 16.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
