### **N. Broadway and W. Jackson Avenue Intersection Reopened** *Final Restoration to Occur Next Week*

KUB has completed its utility work in the N. Broadway and W. Jackson Avenue intersection, and turned the work site over to City of Knoxville. The intersection has been reopened, and final restoration work will be completed early next week by City of Knoxville's paving contractor.

Ahead of final restoration, motorists and marathon runners are advised to use caution in the area. The intersection is open for use, but final paving has not been completed.
