S. Gay Street Bridge Overnight Closure for Utility Work
Overnight September 17-18th

KUB crews will close the S. Gay Street Bridge to vehicles and pedestrians between Main Street and E. Blount Avenue overnight from 7 p.m., Thursday, September 17, through 7 a.m., Friday, September 18, to perform work on the fiber network in the area. Motorists should utilize Henley Street or James White Parkway as alternate routes. Multiple vehicles and crews will be visible in the area.

Also as part of this work, the two righthand, westbound lanes of Neyland Drive at the S. Gay Street Bridge will be closed overnight from 7 p.m., Thursday, September 17, through approximately 4 p.m., Friday, September 18. As work progresses, closed lanes may reopen prior to 4 p.m. Access from James White Parkway to Neyland Drive, along with one westbound lane of Neyland Drive, will remain open during all work hours. Eastbound lanes of traffic will not be impacted by this work, and the Neyland Greenway will also remain open.
