Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Fort Sanders) Twenty-Second Street Traffic Impacts [Overnight, April 8-9]** – KUB crews will implement a lane closure of Twenty-Second Street between White Avenue and Cumberland Avenue overnight from 10 p.m., Wednesday, April 8, through 4 a.m., Thursday, April 9, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. The southbound lane will be closed while the northbound lane will be used to alternate traffic through the work zone. **At some point during the work hours, crews will close the entire roadway for approximately one hour before returning to the single lane closure.** Alternate routes include S. Twenty-First Street. The following night will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
