Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Fort Sanders) S. Twenty-second Street Lane Closure [July 11] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Twenty-second Street to one alternating lane of traffic between Cumberland Avenue and White Avenue from 6 a.m. – 2 p.m., Saturday, July 11, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The southbound lane will be closed while the northbound lane remains open to alternate traffic through the work zone. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Sunday, July 12, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
