Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(South Knoxville) Alcoa Highway Lane Closure [Extended – December 28] – KUB crews will implement a closure of a short section of the curbside, southbound lane of Alcoa Highway at Woodson Drive from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Thursday, December 28, as repairs are made to the electric distribution system in the area. One southbound lane and both northbound lanes will remain open. Flaggers and traffic signage will be site, and drivers are advised to use caution and expect delays in this area.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
