Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures are weather

permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Alta Vista Way Road Closure [April 25]— KUB crews will close a short section of Alta Vista Way between Blows Ferry Road and Arrowhead Trail to through traffic from 8:30 a.m.- 4 p.m., on Thursday, April 25, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Blows Ferry Road and Scenic Drive. Friday, April 26 will be used as a rain date if necessary. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
