Re: Traffic Advisory - Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather

permitting]

(Amherst) Ball Camp Pike Lane Closure [January 4] – KUB crews will reduce a short section of Ball Camp Pike to one alternating lane of traffic between Johnson Road and Barnard Road from 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., Wednesday, January 4, as work is performed on the overhead electric system in the area. One lane will remain open to alternating traffic flow with flaggers present. Access will be maintained to driveways. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures, including flaggers, channeling devices, and barricades, will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
