Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures are weather permitting]

(Karns) Road Closure – Ball Road [May 25] – KUB crews will implement a closure of Ball Road between Red Meadow Road and Zion Lane from 6 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday, May 25, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Ball Road, Johnson Road, Ball camp Pike, and Lobetti Road. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Heiskell) E. Raccoon Valley Drive Lane Closure [Daily, May 28 – August 30] – KUB crews will implement a closure the eastbound lane of E. Raccoon Valley Drive between Diggs Gap Road and Gamble Drive daily, Monday-Friday, from 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The westbound lane will remain open and be used to alternate traffic through the work zone. Occasionally, work may last as late as 7 p.m. in order to reach project milestones. Turn access to area roads and driveways will be maintained.

(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Traffic Impacts [May 28-31] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated traffic control measures during work hours, 7 a.m.- 5 p.m., Tuesday-Friday, May 28-31, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- <u>Daily road closures during work hours:</u>
 Cherokee Boulevard between Tugaloo Drive and Kenesaw Avenue
- Intermittent road closures as needed during work hours:
 - Woodland Drive between Oakhurst Drive and Woodland Court
 - o Bluff View Road between Scenic Drive and Holloway Drive
 - Holloway Drive between Cedarhill Road and Bluff View Road
- Intermittent road closures as needed for concrete restoration. Please notes some of these sections may be closed for up to 24 hours to allow the concrete to set:
 - Iskagna Drive between E. Nokomis Circle and Kenesaw Avenue
 - Windgate Street between Iskagna Drive and Oakhurst Drive
 - W. Nokomis Circle between E. Nokomis Circle and Iskagna Drive
 - o E. Nokomis Circle between W. Nokomis Circle and Iskagna Drive

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
