Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Wooded Acres) Road Closure - Barnard Road [July 24] – KUB crews will implement a road closure of Barnard Road between Ball Camp Pike and Sood Road from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m., Friday, July 24, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Woods-Smith Road, McKamey Road, Amherst Road, and Ball Camp Pike. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Access to area homes and driveway's will be maintained. Monday, July 27, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
