Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills) Bluff Drive Road Closure [Weekdays, November 3 – January 5] – KUB crews close Bluff Drive between both ends at Cherokee Boulevard weekdays between 7 a.m. – 3 p.m. starting Wednesday, November 3, through Wednesday, January 5, as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area. Alternate routes include Cherokee Boulevard. The impacted roadway will reopen after hours and on weekends, and work will not occur on holidays. Local traffic access will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
