Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(South Knox) Taylor Road Temporary Lane Closures [April 18-19]** – KUB contractor crews will implement temporary intermittent lane closures on Taylor Road at the Meadow Court and Bob White Road intersections between 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. on Monday, April 18, and Tuesday, April 19, as work is performed on the water distribution system. The lane closures will only be implemented as needed for short periods of time as water main connections are made in these areas. One lane will remain open at all times with flaggers present to assist with traffic flow. Taylor Road will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of listed work hours.

**(West Knox) Bob Gray Road Lane Closure [April 18-20]** – KUB contractor crews will reduce a short section of Bob Gray Road to one alternating lane of traffic daily between Wilkinson Road and Hearthstone Lane from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. starting Monday, April 18, through Wednesday, April 20, as work is performed on the natural gas system in the area. The westbound lane will be closed, with the eastbound lane remaining open to alternating traffic flow. Access to driveways will be maintained. Bob Gray Road will reopen to normal traffic flow outside of listed work hours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
