Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(West Hills) Road Closure – Broome Road [November 5-6] – KUB crews will implement a closure of Broome Road between Chadwick Drive and Alexander Cavet Drive as indicated below as work is performed on the water distribution system in the area:

- Thursday, November 5, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- Overnight from 10 p.m., Thursday, November 5, through 4 a.m., Friday November 6

The roadway will reopen between the two work time frames. Alternate routes include Middlebrook Pike, N. Gallaher View Road, Chadwick Drive, and Corteland Drive. Flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to area driveways will be maintained. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
