- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Central Avenue Pike Road Closures [Overnight, November 19-20] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of Central Avenue Pike between Inskip Drive and Dalton Place nightly from noon, Sunday, November 16, through 6 a.m., Monday, November 20, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Alternate routes include Inskip Drive, Fennel Road, Coster Drive, Woodlawn Drive, Tillery Drive, and Schubert Road.

(North Knoxville) Central Avenue Pike Lane Closures [November 20-21] – KUB contract crews will reduce a short section of Central Avenue Pike to one alternating lane of traffic between Inskip Drive and Dalton Place from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on Monday, November 20, and Tuesday, November 21, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
