weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Central Avenue Pike Road Closures [Nightly, October 30 – November 9] – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures on a short section of Central Avenue Pike nightly from 6 p.m. – 6 a.m., starting Monday, October 30, through Thursday, November 9, as work is performed on the wastewater collections system in the area:

- Central Avenue Pike between Naueda Drive and Inskip Drive
- Central Avenue Pike between Inskip Drive and Dalton Place Way Inskip Drive will remain open, and alternate routes include Coster Road, Shasta Drive, Cedar Lane, Inskip Drive, and Schubert Road. Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Roadways will reopen outside of work hours and on weekends.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
