- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(North Knoxville) Central Avenue Pike and East Inskip Drive Lane & Road Closures [August 18] – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Friday, August 18, as work is performed on the wastewater collections system in the area:

- **Central Avenue Pike**: northbound lane closed between Naueda Drive and E. Inskip Drive. Southbound lane remains open and used to alternate traffic through the work zone.
- E. Inskip Drive: both lanes closed between Central Avenue Pike and Fennel Road. Alternate routes include Sylvia Drive, Fennel Road, and E. Inskip Drive. W. Inskip Drive will remain open.

Local traffic access to driveways will be maintained, and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. More work will be required in this area in the coming weeks, and advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
