- Re: Traffic Advisory Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Seymour Area) Chapman Highway Lane Closure [April 3] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of the southbound, curbside lane of Chapman Highway between Highland View Drive and W. Simpson Road, from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., on Wednesday, April 3, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One southbound and both northbound lanes will remain open. Access to local public parks and churches will be maintained. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
