Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closure for Utility Work [All closures and work are

weather permitting]

(South Knoxville) Chapman Highway Lane Closure [Overnight, November 30 – December 1] – KUB crews will close a short section of both southbound lanes of Chapman Highway, between Garner Hollow Lane and Flynn Way, overnight beginning at 10 p.m. Thursday, November 30, through 6 a.m., Friday, December 1, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. All southbound traffic will be directed to the center turn lane, and both northbound lanes will remain open to traffic. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control, and access to local businesses will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
