Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closures for Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(South Knox) Chapman Highway Rolling Roadblocks [Overnight, October 26-27] – KUB crews in conjunction with Tennessee Department of Transportation, will implement a series of rolling roadblocks of Chapman Highway between Anderson Drive and East Dick Ford Lane overnight from 7 p.m., Tuesday, October 26, through 6 a.m., Wednesday, October 27, to safely pull spans of wire across the roadway. Traffic flow on both sides of the roadway will be stopped briefly up to 4 times to complete work. Appropriate traffic control operators and law enforcement will be on site. The following night, October 27-28, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
