Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(South Knox) Chapman Highway Lane Closures [February 14 - 17] – KUB contract crews will implement lane closures on Chapman Highway between Michaels Lane and E. Norton Road daily from 9 a.m. – 2 p.m., starting Monday, February 14, through Thursday, February 17, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. Crews will work in the northbound curbside lane with the inside northbound lane remaining open to traffic flow. Additionally, the righthand turn lane will be closed between Michaels Lane and Majestic Grove Boulevard and at Chapman Triangle Way when crews are working in those areas. Both southbound lanes and the Chapman Highway at Majestic Grove Boulevard intersection will remain open. Flaggers and signage will be on site to assist with traffic control.

(Sequoyah Hills) Traffic Impacts [February 14-18] – KUB contract crews will implement the below traffic control measures as indicated daily from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, February 14, through Friday, February 18, as work continues on the wastewater collection system in the area:

- Intermittent road closures
 - Bluff Drive between Cherokee Boulevard and Cheowa Circle
 - Keowee Avenue between Cherokee Boulevard and Iskagna Drive

Residential access will be maintained, and through traffic should follow the onsite detours. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
