Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(Sequoyah Hills Area) Cherokee Boulevard Median Closure [February 6] – KUB crews will implement a median closure of a short section of Cherokee Boulevard between Cheowa Circle and Bluff Drive from 7:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., Wednesday February 6, as work is performed on the gas distribution system in the area. Traffic in both directions will be maintained, however greenway access in this section will be closed. Flaggers and signs will be on site to assist with motor and pedestrian traffic. Thursday, February 7, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
