Re: Traffic Advisory - Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather

permitting]

(Northwest Knoxville) Road Closure – Clifton Road [April 27-28] – KUB crews will close a short section of Clifton Road between Sanderson Road and Whedbee Drive to through traffic from 6 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Saturday, April 27, and Sunday, April 28, as work is performed on the water distribution and wastewater collection system in the area. Alternate routes include Sanderson Road, Whedbee Drive and Chillicothe Street. Access to driveways will be maintained, and the road will reopen to normal traffic flow when crews are not present. Appropriate signage, flaggers, and barricades will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(South Knoxville) Sevier Avenue Road Closure [April 28] – KUB crews will close Sevier Avenue at Barber Street between Davenport Road and Claude Street to through traffic from 6 a.m. – 4 p.m., on Sunday, April 28, as work is performed on the water distribution and wastewater collection systems in the area. Alternate routes include Davenport Road, Phillips Avenue, and Claude Street. Access to area businesses will be maintained. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Intermittent Road Closures [April 29 – May 3] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated road closures intermittently only as needed, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., starting Monday, April 29, through Friday, May 3, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Iskagna Drive between Kenesaw Avenue and E. Nokomis Circle (Iskagna Drive and Windgate Drive will not be closed at the same time)
- East Nokomis Circle between Iskagna Drive and W. Nokomis Circle
- Windgate Street between Iskagna Drive and Oakhurst Drive
- Kenesaw Avenue between Iskagna Drive and Talahi Drive

Access to area homes will be maintained, and barricades and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Sequoyah Hills) Sequoyah Hills Area Daily Road Closures [April 29 – May 3] – KUB contract crews will implement the below indicated road closures daily from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., starting Monday, April 29, through Friday, May 3, as work continues on the wastewater collection system project in the area:

- Bluff View Road between Scenic Drive and Holloway Drive
- Taliluna Avenue between Southgate Road and Wilani Road

Access to area homes will be maintained, and barricades and signs will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(North Knoxville) Old Broadway Lane Closures [April 29-May 5] – KUB contract crews will implement daily closures of the northbound, curbside lane on the section of Old Broadway from the I-640 exit ramp to Broadway to Tazewell Pike from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m., beginning Monday, April 29, through Thursday, May 9, as work is performed on the electric distribution system in the area. One northbound lane and both southbound lanes will remain open. Access to businesses will be





maintained. Appropriate signage and flaggers will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(Downtown) N. Gay Street Lane Closure [April 29-30] – KUB crews will close a short section of the southbound, curbside lane and sidewalk of N. Gay Street between W. Fifth Avenue and W. Magnolia Avenue, from 8 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., on both Monday, April 29, and Tuesday, April 30, as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The northbound lane will remain open during this time and be used to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to area businesses will be maintained. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Wednesday, May 1, will be used as a rain date if necessary. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

(West Knoxville) Harvey Road Lane Closure [April 29-May 10] – KUB contract crews will close a short section of the northbound, curbside lane of Harvey Road between S. Northshore Drive and Hunters Creek Lane daily, from 8 a.m. – 3:30 p.m., beginning on Monday, April 29, through Friday, May 10 as work is performed on the natural gas distribution system in the area. The southbound lane will remain open during this time and be used to alternate traffic through the work zone. Access to driveways will be maintained. Flaggers and signs will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
