Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

**(Fort Sanders) Cumberland Avenue Lane Closure [July 19]** – KUB crews will close a short section of the westbound lane of Cumberland Avenue between S. Twenty-second Street and Volunteer Boulevard to traffic from 6 a.m. – 4 p.m., Sunday, July 19, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Westbound traffic will be detoured to S. Twenty-second Street, Lake Avenue, and Volunteer Boulevard. Access to area businesses will be maintained.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
