Re: Traffic Advisory – Lane/Road Closure Utility Work [All closures and work are weather permitting]

(UT Area) Cumberland Avenue Lane Closures [June 4 & 5] – KUB contract crews will implement the below lane closures of Cumberland Avenue between James Agee Street and Sixteenth Street from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. on both Tuesday, June 4, and Wednesday, June 5, for roadway restoration work:

- Tuesday – crews will close both westbound lanes. One eastbound lane will be used for westbound traffic.
- Wednesday – crews will close both eastbound lanes. One westbound lane will be used for eastbound traffic.

Flaggers and signage will be on site for traffic control. Thursday, June 6, will be used as a rain date if necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
