## (UT Area) Cumberland Avenue Alternating Lane, 11th Street Road Closure

[December 19-22] – KUB contract crews will implement alternating lane closures of both eastbound and westbound Cumberland Avenue at the 11<sup>th</sup> Street intersection, as well as closing 11<sup>th</sup> Street between Cumberland Avenue and White Avenue, from 7 a.m., Wednesday, December 19, through 7 a.m., Saturday, December 22, as work is performed on the wastewater collection system in the area. Traffic flow will be maintained in both directions on Cumberland Avenue at all times as work is completed, and appropriate signage will be on site to assist with traffic control. Follow-up advisories will be issued as necessary.

Some listed closures may extend beyond the scheduled times depending on the conditions encountered during excavation and construction. Appropriate traffic control measures will be in place at each location to assist motorists traveling in these areas. Due to the ongoing presence of workers and equipment, motorists are advised to use caution and expect temporary delays in these areas. Tennessee's **Move Over Law** requires motorists approaching a utility vehicle with flashing lights to move over if safe to do so, creating an empty lane buffer. When changing lanes is not possible, motorists must reduce speed.
